Assistant Director, NFPW Professional Communications Contest

The Assistant Contest Director works closely with the NFPW Professional Contest Director to manage the national competition and serves as a resource to affiliate contest directors as they direct their state competitions. This is a volunteer position.

The assistant director's work may include:

- Promoting the contest by producing content for NFPW publications, web and social media.
- Assisting the At-Large Contest Team as they answer entrant questions and vet entries.
- Assisting the national director in developing resources for and supporting the work of affiliate contest directors in the first phase of the competition.
- Working with the national director to identify judges for the national competition, manage the judging process, announce winners and present awards at the national conference.

The responsibilities assigned to the assistant director may vary based on the interests, talents and experience of the person selected with the goal of preparing that person to serve as national contest director in the future.
